



RULES APPLYING TO THE MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOL IN ZINAL

1. Any person entering the swimming pool has to conform to the provisions of the present rules and follow the instructions and directives given by the personnel.
2. Order and decency must be observed inside and around the building. Any behaviour or action that could endanger the security of users, as well as any action which could deteriorate or damage the installations or building are prohibited and offenders can be sued.
3. Any unlawful entry to the pool will be followed by a written report by the person in charge and could entail sanctions according to pt. 4 as well as the payment of a fine of Fr. 200.-.
4. Any person not respecting these rules can be expelled. Depending on the gravity of the offense, the Municipality can forbid temporary or permanent entrance and withdraw the season ticket without any compensation, keeping open the option of further sanctions stipulated by other legal dispositions or rules.
5. The groups of 10 to 30 persons maximum, the accompanying persons in more, announce their coming, by phone, the day before, before 7:30 p.m. The groups are accepted from the opening and until 3:30 p.m. The arrival time must be respected, because other groups may come. The maximal duration in the pool is one hour.

The accompanying persons are obliged to respect the dress code, including the wearing of swimming costume, on the area of the pool, even if they don't bathing.

The « Pass Anniviers Liberté » (or other) must be presented.
6. The Municipality is entitled to :
 - closing parts of the pool to the public at certain hours for swimming lessons or other water sports;
 - if needed, interrupting temporarily the use of part or all of the pool without any reduction or reimbursement of the entry fee.
7. Tickets for “ **1 entry** ” and tickets for “ **10 entries** ” are not day passes. Any person leaving the pool area has to pay again if desiring to re-enter.

Tickets for “10 entries” are valid one year from the date of issue. Beyond this date, unused entries are lost without reimbursement.

8. For security reasons, the pool personnel is entitled to open the doors of the changing rooms or toilets whenever a check seems necessary.
9. Persons with open wounds, skin disorders or contagious diseases cannot be admitted into the pool area.

The following are not allowed:

- to eat, drink, smoke or chew gum in the changing rooms and pool area;
- to enter the pool when drunk;
- to throw away papers, chewing gum or any rubbish anywhere else than in the rubbish bins provided.

10. It is required :

- to get changed in the changing rooms and to put clothes in the lockers;
- to use soap solely in the showers;
- to take a shower before entering the pool.

11. It is forbidden :

- to do somersaults or jumps in unauthorized depths of the pool
- to run around the pool, to shove or throw persons into the water;
- to enter the pool in other garments than bathing suits;
- to enter with animals, strollers, rollerblades, skateboards or similar objects;
- to use private electric or electronic devices.

12. Any lost property must be given to the pool personnel.

13. Children of any age who do not know how to swim must be accompanied by an adult at all times. The Municipality declines any responsibility in case of accident.

14. Any user of the swimming pool is personally responsible for any accident he may cause.

The Municipality declines all responsibility in case of accident, damage, loss, theft, unintentional exchange of clothes even if locked in lockers or changing rooms.

Remain reserved cases where the Municipality accepts responsibility in accordance with legal dispositions.

15. Any complaint must be sent in writing to the Municipality of Anniviers.
